BDC'S 2024 IMPACT: INVESTING IN GROWTH AND PROSPERITY

For more than 67 years, Business Development Corporation (BDC) has been a cornerstone of South Carolina's small business ecosystem, fueling growth and prosperity through strategic investments. Our enduring commitment is evident in our historical impact to date, as BDC has invested over \$2.04 billion in South Carolina businesses via 3,261 small business loans.

Our 2024 Impact Report highlights our recent activities, showcasing the tangible results of our programs and partnerships. Specifically, this year's report shines a spotlight on the on-going success of the SSBCI 2.0 Loan Participation Program. In 2024 alone, the program received 108 applications, approved 75 loans, and successfully closed 70 loans totaling \$15.8 million. This reflects a robust application volume with a strong 69% approval rate. Since its inception, the SSBCI 2.0 program has closed 134 loans, injecting \$31.8 million into South Carolina's small businesses.

Furthermore, this report provides a detailed overview of our 2024 loan distribution. BDC provided 90 loans totaling nearly \$27 million, reaching businesses across 20 counties in South Carolina and one in North Carolina. We are pleased to have supported a varied range of communities, with notable investment in Charleston, Greenville, Lexington, and Richland counties.




LOAN VOLUME | 2021-2024






LOAN VOLUME BY AMOUNT (MILLIONS)



LOAN VOLUME BY AMOUNT (MILLIONS)




